- ENABLING SOCIAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND DEVELOPMENT - innovative modality of entrepreneurship for enhancing labor quality and skills among sub-contractors in the supply chain, and even of discovering new raw materials and products.

4. The Asian CSR Award Programme was organized to recognize and honor Asian companies for embodying the principles of corporate responsibility in their business philosophy and operations. The four focus areas are as follows:
