B. Background, Description and Objectives of the Activity

Harmonization of Technical and Vocational Education and Training programme or Southeast Asia TVET or SEA TVET is one of SEAMEO's project 2015 which already been supported by the SEAMEO Council at the 48th SEAMEO Council conference. For the clear participation and implementation, on 28 May 2015, Department of Technical and Vocational education, Ministry of Education and Culture, Indonesia has invited 40 TVET institutes and 5 teacher training centres to participate the seminar to be informed and discussed about the update SEA TVET Programme and to consult with them about the implementation. On 29 May, SEAMEO Secretariat and SEAMEO SEAMOLEC has participated a meeting of 60 polytechnics to have a discussion on the same topics. This meeting was arranged by the Ministry of Higher Education. The presentation for both meetings is arranged for

1. Inform updates of the project "Harmonization of Technical and Vocational Education and Training, or SEA TVET" to MOEC, Indonesia and TVET institutes from Java Island/Polytechnics from all over Indonesia.
2. Strengthen the network between TVET institutes/polytechnics in Java Island area.
3. Consult and discuss with Java Island TVET leaders and Teacher Training Institutes leaders/polytechnics about the updated SEA TVET programme.

C. Expected Outputs from the seminar:

1. Leading TVET institutes from Java Island have clear comprehension of the updated SEA TVET programme
2. TVET institutes show interest to participate activities in this project.
3. Ministry of Education and Culture, Ministry of Research, Technology, and Higher Education, Indonesia, SEAMEO Secretariat, and SEAMEO SEAMOLEC gain recommendations for the development of the involving programme.

F. Highlights of Activity/Summary Points

1. On 28 May 2015, after SEAMES' presentation, there was a roundtable discussion of SEA TVET programme which provide suggestions and concerns as follows: 1) The age of student internship as varied from one country to another which might be difficult for the mobility, 2) The number of TVET students from Indonesia is larger than those of other countries, need to think about how to balance this number, 3) The internationalization programme might be useful for some schools but not others which already have internationalized programmes with institutes in other countries.

2. On 29 May 2015, after the SEAMES presentation, leaders of polytechnic institutes in Indonesia concerned about the monitoring of the programme. Furthermore, they showed high interest in participating all SEA TVET programmes since the High Official meetings, the Leadership Training, and the SEA-VOCTECH-DAAD programme. Some offered voluntary payment of travelling expenses to join these programmes via SEAMEO's invitation.

G. Role/Participation of SEAMEO Secretariat

1. To inform the Ministries, as well as the participating TVET leader institutes/polytechnics institutes about updated information about the SEA TVET programme for their consideration in joining the project later.
2. To be a representative from SEAMEO Secretariat supporting the Indonesia Ministries promotion of the SEA TVET programme.

H. Follow-up actions needed

1. Pass concerns and recommendations from the meeting for SEA TVET Programme's development to SEAMEO VOCTECH and responsible centres.
2. Inform directorate high interest of Indonesia Polytechnic leaders to participate the SEA TVET Programmes for further actions.
