#### B. Background

The concept of an annual forum for High Officials of Basic Education of SEAMEO Member Countries and Associate Members was proposed by the SEAMEO Secretariat and approved by the SEAMEO Council at the 45<sup>th</sup> SEAMEO Council Conference in Cebu, Philippines in 26 January 2010. The forum aims to facilitate the exchange of best practices and experiences on various areas and issues on basic education. It is intended to serve as platform to reflect on ways to further enhance the provision of basic education and gain insights from each other by sharing and exchanging ideas. Moreover, the forum intends to foster regular and active fellowship among High Officials responsible for Basic Education in SEAMEO Member Countries and Associate Members.

The first forum was hosted by the Ministry of Education, Malaysia on 8-11 November 2010 in Genting Highlands, Malaysia, with the theme "Basic Education: Pathway to 21<sup>st</sup> Century Human Development". The second forum then was hosted by the Ministry of Education and Training, Vietnam, on 18-20 October 2011 in Danang, Vietnam, with the theme "Sharing and Embracing the Development of Inclusive Education in Southeast Asian Countries".

The 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Forum for High Officials of Basic Education of SEAMEO Member Countries and Associate Members was hosted by the Ministry of Education, Thailand on 12-14 February 2013, in Nonthaburi, Thailand, with the theme "Quality and Equity of Basic Education for Sustainable Future: Building Capacity for Every Learner". It follows that the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Forum for High Officials of Basic Education of SEAMEO Member Countries and Associate Members was hosted by the Ministry of Education, Brunei Darussalam on 11-12 June 2014 in Gadong, Brunei Darussalam, with the theme

"Promoting Entrepreneurship Education and Culture Within the Basic Education System".

## C. Objectives of the Forum

- 1. To keep abreast with the current regional and global trends, issues and challenges concerning quality assurance in basic education.
- 2. To share knowledge of best practices relating to quality assurance in basic education.
- 3. To explore potential areas for collaboration on quality assurance in basic education among SEAMEO Member Countries and Associate Members.

### D. Expected Results

- 1. Enhance knowledge and the implementation of programmes, projects, initiatives, policies and national curriculum, in providing quality education to the primary and secondary school students.
- 2. Strengthen cooperation among SEAMEO Member Countries and Associate Members with the aim of achieving quality basic education.

#### E. Participants

The participants consisted of High Officials of Basic Education from the Ministries of Education of Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam. The participants also consisted of Centre Directors and focal person from SEAMEO QITEP in Mathematics, SEAMEO QITEP in Science and SEAMEO RECSAM respectively.

  - 2. Pathways: 1) Country's priority (National goals); 2) Country's context (law, culture, system, needs); 3) More Countries moving towards Holistic education; and 4) More Countries provide multiple pathways.
  - 3. Similarities: 1) Utilization of Internal Assessment & External Assessment; 2) Implementing inspection system; 3) Having Quality Assurance Units; and 4) Areas of quality.
  - 4. Areas of Quality: 1) Leadership; 2) Governance (example, management and budget); 3) Curriculum; 4) Teaching and learning; 5) Resources (example, facilities and environment); 6) Learners; and 7) Community participation.
  - 5. Uniqueness: 1) Tool to diagnose and not to measure (Singapore case); 2) Quantity vs. quality (Indonesia case); 3) Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) (Brunei case); and 4) Teacher development (Philippines case).
  - 6. Challenges and Observation: 1) Process vs. reflection; 2) Teachers quality; 3) Students with special needs; and 4) ECCE.
