3. The workshop aims to build a regional outlook into student experience and internationalization strategies of university
 4. The SHARE transparency tools such as quality assurance and qualifications framework or credit transfer system were promoted
 5. The ASEAN Higher Education space and credit transfer agreements were reviewed
 6. The ASEAN and European Credit Transfer Scheme were shared and
 7. The roles of the ASEAN Secretariat and SEAMEO were agreed upon in terms of student mobility.
