### A. Background and Objectives

1 One of the role of SEAMEO Council President is to visit SEAMEO Member Countries during the presidentship. His Excellency will pay a courtesy call on Minister of visiting country, and visit to SEAMEO Regional Centres in that respective country as well.

### B. Highlight of the Activity

2 On 1 March 2018, H E Prof Dr Muhadjir Effendy, Minister of Education and Culture, Indonesia cum SEAMEO Council President launched the PKBM KBRI Kuala Lumpur at the Embassy of Indonesia in Kaula Lumpur.

3 His Excellency visited and listed to the brief from Dr Safani Bari, Acting Centre Director and Deputy Director (Research & Training) of SEAMEO SEN and Dato' Dr Fadzilah Kamaludin, Director of IMR and Centre Director of SEAMEO TROPMED/Malaysia respectively.

4 His Excellency visited the Indonesia-Kuala Lumpur School in Kuala Lumpur. In this occasion, His Excellency opened the floor for Q&A with the teacher and students of school.

5 His Excellency and delegates departed KL in the morning of 2 March to Penang. Upon arrival, His Excellency visited the Consulate-General of the Embassy of Indonesia. His Excellency spent time in talking/interviewing the Indonesian migrant at the Office of Consulate-General.

6 His Excellency delivered a Speech and gave Award Presentation at the 11<sup>th</sup> Regional Congress on Search for SEAMEO Young Scientists (SSYS 2018) convened by SEAMEO RECSAM.
