1. **Pre-Workshop consultations** was scheduled with UGM and SEAMES on the 19<sup>th</sup> of March. The main activities, final programme and expected deliverables were agreed.
2. **Opening Session** was done with messages from UGM officials, the Vice President of UGM gave a welcome remarks as well as Dr Gatot, SEAMEO Secretariat director
3. **Workshop Sessions**- The ESD Orientation on SEA ESD activities was provided by Dr Ushio
  - The rationale of the SEA ESD workshop was given by DDPD of SEAMEO Secretariat.
  - The overview of ESD Concepts and Practices was given by DDPD of SEAMES.
  - ESD in TEIS were also presented highlighting the programmes, activities and challenges for SEA ESD.
  - An integration of SEA ESD challenges were laid out and the ESD Framework was revisited.
