B. Background, Description and Objectives of the Activity

1. To promote the quality and standard of TVET education in Southeast Asian countries, it is necessary for the TVET institutions to enhance the global competitiveness of TVET graduates to be equipped with skills and knowledge that meet needs of industry, and prepare them with skills and competencies for the 21st century and ASEAN community. “Entrepreneurship” is one of the important skills and knowledge that TVET institutions should integrate into the curriculum for improving the learning competencies and quality of TVET education of the institution.
2. In addition, the 3rd High Officials Meeting on SEA-TVET, in Kuala Lumpur, May 2017 highlighted that the TVET institutions in Southeast Asia should improve the quality of TVET by promoting the sharing of innovative TVET teaching and learning practices and entrepreneurship education.
3. In response to the needs of the region, the Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organisation Secretariat (SEAMEO Secretariat) in collaboration with Ministry of Education and Culture Indonesia, SEAMEO SEAMOLEC and Selamat Pagi Indonesia Senior High School (SMA Selamat Pagi Indonesia) organised a “Workshop on Modeling TVET Colleges for Entrepreneurship” on 7 April 2018 at SMA Selamat Pagi Indonesia, Malang, Indonesia.
4. The workshop was organised back to back with the Workshop on 100 Modeling Schools for Entrepreneurship organised by the Department of Technical and Vocational Education, Ministry of Education and Culture Indonesia.

5. This workshop is a part of SEA-TVET Programme to promote quality and standard of Technical and Vocational Education and Training through developing and sharing innovative teaching and learning practices for improving students' global competitiveness.

Objectives

1. To learn the best practices for integrating entrepreneurship into the teaching and learning activities by learning the practices of Selamat Pagi Indonesia Senior High School.
2. To develop an action plan for embracing and improving entrepreneurial skills and knowledge in teaching and learning strategies of TVET institutions
3. To establish collaboration among the participating institutions for improving teaching and learning practices for entrepreneurship
