



Mission Report:

Accompanying SEAMEO Council President visit to Vietnam from 22 to 26 July 2018

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Executive Secretary

A. Background and Objectives

1 One of the roles of SEAMEO Council President is to visit SEAMEO Member Countries during his presidency. His Excellency will pay a courtesy call on Minister of visiting country, and visit to SEAMEO Regional Centres in that respective country as well.

B. Highlight of the Activity

2 H E Prof Dr Muhadjir Effendy, Minister of Education and Culture, Indonesia and SEAMEO Council President paid a courtesy call on H E Prof Dr Phung Xuan Nha, Minister of Education and Training, Vietnam on 23 July 2018. The discussion focused on PISA Assessment in Vietnam. MoEC Indonesia will send a staff to learn from Vietnam on how to improve the learning outcome to get a higher PISA scores.

3 In the afternoon, His Excellency visited and listened to the school presentation of the Director of Da Phuc High School in Soc Son, Hanoi. The schools established in September 1963. From 2003, the school got several outstanding achievements and award from the Government of Vietnam. At present, the total number of students are 1,484 persons with 36 classes. The staff and teachers are 86 persons, which are 3 board member, 73 teachers, and 10 staff.

4 On 24 July 2018, His Excellency visited SEAMEO RETRAC and SEAMEO CELLL in Ho Chi Minh City. The Directors of SEAMEO RETRAC and SEAMEO CELLL brief the SEAMEO Council President and delegates on their Centre's activities during the past year as well as its strategic direction for development in the upcoming period. His Excellency planted the tree at the ground of SEAMEO RETRAC; while SEAMEO CELLL took this opportunity to launch the SEAMEO-LLL Portal e-resources activation.

5 After that, His Excellency and the delegates visited Hung Vuong High School in Ho Chi Minh City. The school established in 1934 with the name of Do Huu Phuong Primary School, Hung Vuong Secondary and High School, and at present, the school name is Hung Vuong High School. The total area of school is 22,400 square metres with 4 suites including classrooms, computer labs, audio-visual rooms, and multi-functioned room along with spacious courtyard system. The total number of students from Grade 10 to Grade 12 are 3,258 persons with 75 classes. There are 4 school boards, 156 teachers, and 31 staff. The school participate in the PISA assessment since 2015.
