B. Background, Description and Objectives of the Activity

1. SEAMEO Regional Centre for QITEP in Mathematics or SEAQiM will end up its 2nd Five Year Development Plan (FYDP) in 2020. Moreover, SEAQiM will also have its new Director as the predecessor has been appointed at DDPD at SEAMEO Secretariat, Bangkok, Thailand.
2. In line with this, SEAQiM management invited DDPD as the former Director of SEAQiM to the said meeting. The meeting and workshop aimed to discuss the past and ongoing programme delivered by the SEAQiM. DDPD provided his views and suggestion as the input for SEAQiM to further develop and revise its 3rd FYDP draft. It is expected that SEAQiM will present one Working Paper on its 3rd FYDP during the Centre Director Meeting (CDM) to be held in August 2019 at Bangkok, Thailand.

E. Highlight of the Activity/Summary Points

1. On Monday, 10 June 2019, DDPD and the BoD of SEAQiM met at SEAQiM office to discuss the procedure of appointment SEAQiM Director according to the Enabling Instrument. DDPD explained to the BoDs that the new SEAQiM Director has to be appointed by the SEAMEC President. In so doing, the nominee should be endorsed first by SEAQiM Governing Board members – in this case by referendum. After the endorsement is secured, SEAQiM should send the letter to SEAMEO Secretariat for appointment by SEAMEC President. SEAQiM has sent the letter to its GB members and wait for their responses.

2. The meeting should be done on Tuesday, 11 June 2019. However, to DDPD amend the schedule to accommodate the request of Dr Uwes of the MORTHE in which the DDPD should collect the monetary prize for the 3rd SEA Creative Camp Winner on Tuesday, 11 June 2019.
3. On Wednesday morning, 12 June 2019, DDAP and the BoDs of SEAQiM discussed and shared their thoughts toward the SEQiM's direction in this dynamic era of technology. The rapid change and advance of technology are seen as both opportunity and tread (challenges) for all SEQiM's people.
4. DDPD then sharing his view to all SEAQiM staff and reiterate on how the SWOT analysis being considered as an approach in developing and reviewing the draft of the 3rd FYDP of SEAQiM.

F. Side Meeting

1. On Tuesday 11 June 2019, DDPD flew to Jakarta to coordinate with Dr Uwes of the MORTHE and able to finalize the payment of monetary prize for the winners of the 3rd SEA Creative Camp sponsored by the MORTHE.

G. Follow-up Actions Needed

1. DDPD will be updated with the revised Draft of 3rd FYDP of SEAQIM for review and further suggestion.
2. Proper handover of SEAQiM's Directorship will be done upon the official appointment of the SEAQiM Director in July 2019.
3. The monetary prize received from Dr Uwes of the MORTHE will be distributed to the winners through Bank Transfer.
