B. Background, Description and Objectives of the Activity

The Regional Workshop “Human Resources Development for a Fast-Changing World” on 14 and 15 October 2019, in Ha Long, Viet Nam was hosted by the Ministry of Labour, Invalids and Social Affairs of Viet Nam (MOLISA) in cooperation with the ASEAN Secretariat, and the German government’s TVET cooperation programme for the ASEAN region (RECOTVET).

The workshop represented the kick-off for a series of events and activities in the context of Viet Nam’s ASEAN Chairmanship 2020 that address the need to make the ASEAN region fit for an era of technological progress and related economic and social transformations. In particular, the workshop intends to set the agenda for the development of ASEAN Declaration on Human Resources Development to be discussed by ASEAN Heads of State at the 37th ASEAN Summit hosted by Vietnam in 2020.

C. Objectives of the meeting

The workshop is designed to get all participants actively involved in defining the priorities and agreement for Human Resources Development in the ASEAN region.
