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B. Background, Description and Objectives of the Activity

1. HE Minister Nadiem Anwar Makarim of MOEC Indonesia called for a meeting with the diplomatic community including SEAMEO to present MOEC roadmap under his present leadership.
2. The Minister invited all the members of the diplomatic corp as well as UNESCO, UNICEF, SEAMEO, ADB and the World Bank in the meeting.
3. The Minister laid out his agenda for the next generation of Indonesia.

C. Highlight of the Activity/Summary Points

1. Ministers Presentation –
 - a. HE Nadiem talked about his roadmap that includes his targets in 5 areas: 1) ecosystem; 2) teacher; 3) pedagogy; 4) programme and curriculum and 5) Assessment and testing
 - b. He discussed the current state of the 5 categories and laid his plan for the future goals: 1) School as a joyful experience with open system, collaborative and competent management; 2) teachers as co-owners and co-creators of the curriculum and their performance evaluated holistically; 3) students will lead the change and use team activity to develop their full potentials; 4) curriculum is flexible and competency-based, and employee industry driven; and 5) use of formative assessment and portfolio-based.
2. Ministers talked about the Breakthroughs in 100 days.
3. He also presented his priority areas where MOEC will be asking and needing the support, such as:
 - a. basic and secondary education- developing scorecard for local government and incentives to increase performance; next generation school spaces;
 - b. teachers, principals and supervisors- independent international evaluation panel for teacher education programmes, sending teachers to training

programmes, sending school principals and supervisors to school leadership training programme

- c. vocational educational – establish best in-class vocational institutions, training and certifying SMK teachers and polytechnic instructors, training SMK principals and directors, sharing best practices and grants for infrastructure improvements
- d. higher education – Bringing foreign universities to Indonesia, identify research interests of top faculty, placement to real-world working experience and bringing in people with industry experience to teach in universities
- e. Culture- joint fund and travel grants for cultural actors, support international artists in areas where Indonesia do not have the capacity such as museum, film archivist, film presentation and underwater archaeology

D. Role/Participation of SEAMEO

1. SEAMEO Director presented the areas for collaboration as well how SEAMEO centers can support the key initiatives of the Minister.

E. Side Meeting/s

1. Meeting with the ASEAN Secretariat Education, Youth and Sports Division
 - a. The 2020 ASEAN SEAMEO Coordination Meeting- It is proposed that it will be held in Jakarta from 9-13 March (tentative). Issues to be discussed are on creation of the Technical working committee to study SEAMEO and ASEAN with the leaders of both countries.
 - b. SEA PLM- The meeting also talked about the status of SEA PLM proposal to ASEAN Secretariat and the request of KICE and KEDI for specific TOR

1. MOEC- submit an updated SEAMEO-MOEC programme of Cooperation (by PO 2)
2. Prepare a counter-proposal for ASEAN on the Streamlining of ASEAN and SEAMEO activities (PO 1)
